16. The largest unsupported dome in Europe is in Buxton, what is it called?

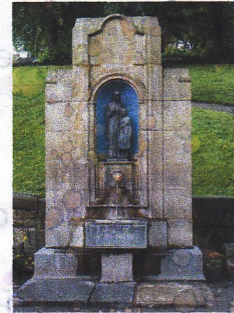
Devonshire Dome

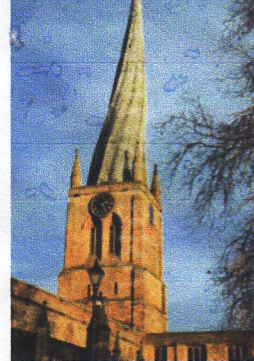
